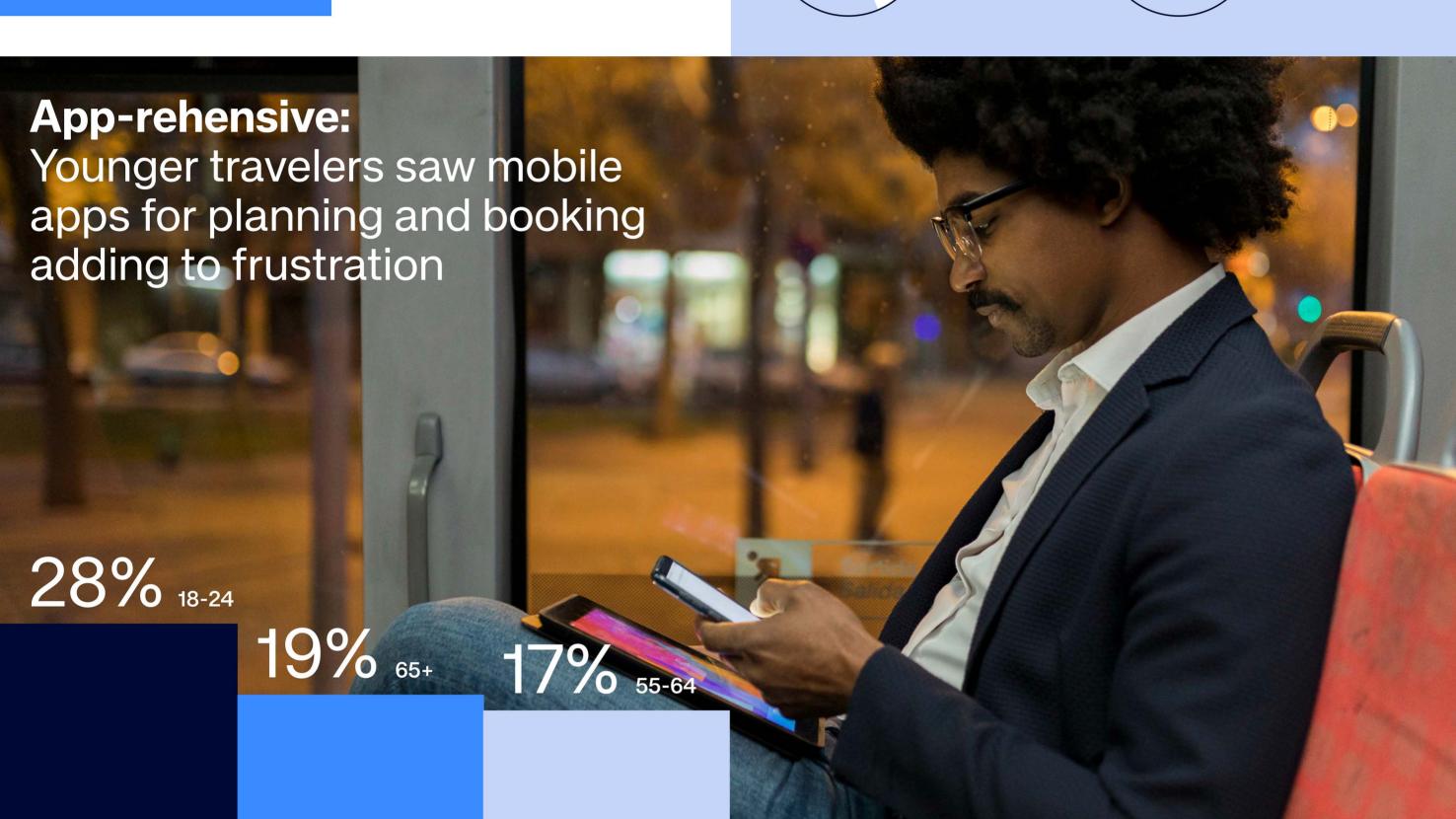
Older travelers are more resilient when on the road

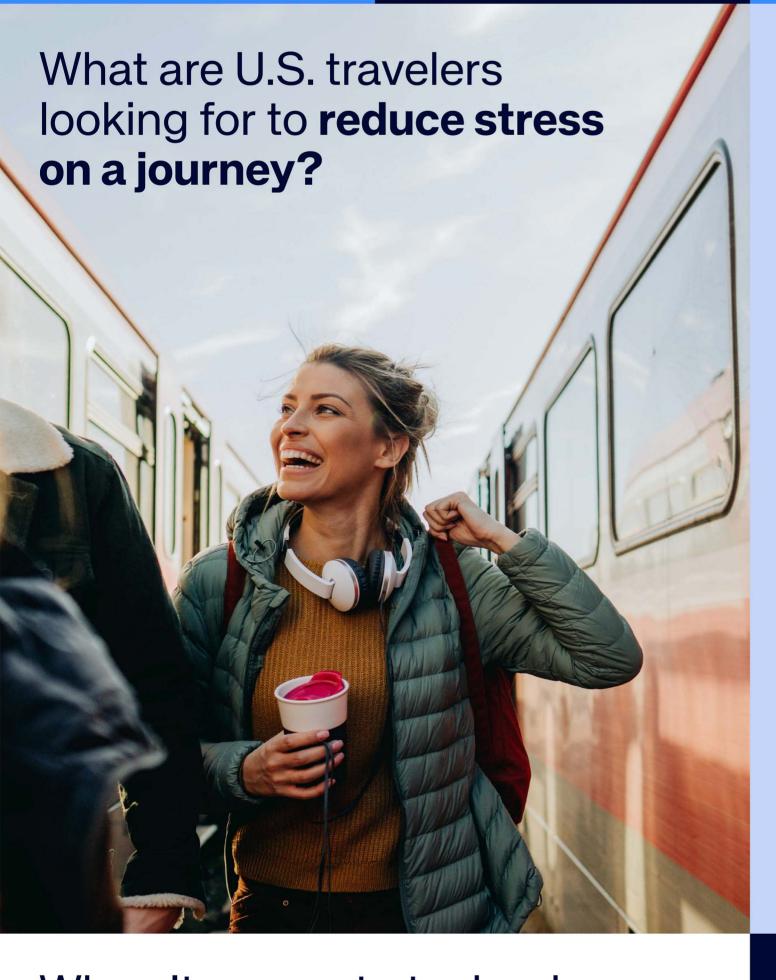
